VOTING PLACES

The voting place will be open for voting on Wednesday the 26th day of October, 2022 between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at the Ste. Anne Maurice Chaput Arena, 51 Arena Road, Ste. Anne, MB.

IDENTIFICATION MAY BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO VOTE. A person may be required to produce one piece of government issued photo identification (for example - driver's license) or at least two other documents that provide proof of identity.

ADVANCE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but who have reason to believe that they will be absent or otherwise unable to attend their proper voting place on election day, an advance voting opportunity will be located at the Town of Ste. Anne Municipal Office, 14 Centrale Avenue, Ste. Anne, MB, and will be open Thursday, October 13th, 2022 between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

MOBILE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but reside at a health care facility, a mobile voting station will be set up at the following health care facilities on Wednesday, October 26th, 2022.

1. Ste. Anne Hospital, 52 Saint Gerard Street, Ste. Anne, MB
2. Villa Youville, 15 Charriere Road, Ste. Anne, MB

APPLICATION TO VOTE BY SEALED ENVELOPE

A voter who is unable to go in person to the voting place or vote in advance, may apply in person, in writing, or by email to the senior election official at Town of Ste. Anne office, 14 Centrale Avenue, Ste. Anne, MB. R5H 1B8, Email: town@steanne.ca. The application form is available on the Town's website.

If applying in person*, a voter may apply between September 28 and October 23, 2022.

* A voter applying in person may pick up a sealed envelope ballot package at the time of application during regular office hours (Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.).

If applying by mail or email**, a voter may apply between July 28 and October 23, 2022.

** A voter applying by mail or email will receive a sealed envelope ballot package by regular post, or by making alternative arrangements with the senior election official.
