## NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that a vote of the Town of Ste. Anne will be taken to elect a Councillor from the following duly nominated candidates:

### VOTING PLACES

The voting place will be open for voting on Wednesday the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 2021 between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at the Ste. Anne Curling Arena, 55 Arena Road, Ste. Anne, MB.

**IDENTIFICATION WILL BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO VOTE.** A person will be required to produce one piece of government issued photo identification (for example - driver's license or passport) or at least two other documents that provide proof of identity.

### ADVANCE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but who have reason to believe that they will be absent or otherwise unable to attend their proper voting place on election day, an advance voting opportunity will be located at the Ste. Anne Curling Arena, 55 Arena Road, Ste. Anne, MB, and will be open Wednesday, June 16, 2021 between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

Voters are also encouraged to take advantage of advance voting if they are feeling well on June 16.

**Note: Public Health Regulations will be adhered to and enforced. For both election day and advance voting, masks will be required to be worn, and will not be provided by the Town.**

### MOBILE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but reside at a health care facility, a mobile voting station will be set up at the following health care facilities on a day yet to be determined due to COVID-19 restrictions:

1. Ste. Anne Hospital, 52 Saint Gerard Street, Ste. Anne, MB
2. Villa Youville, 15 Charriere Road, Ste. Anne, MB

### APPLICATION TO VOTE BY SEALED ENVELOPE

**Eligible voters, especially those with medical conditions, as well as those who because of COVID-19 wish to minimize interaction with others, are strongly encouraged to vote by sealed envelope.**

A voter who is unable to go in person to the voting place or vote in advance, may apply in person, in writing, or by fax to the senior election official at the Town of Ste. Anne office, 30B Dawson Road, Ste. Anne, MB. R5H 1B5, Email: [town@steanne.ca](mailto:town@steanne.ca), Fax. 204-422-5459. The application form is available on the Town's website.

If applying in person\*, a voter may apply between May 26 and June 20, 2021.

\* A voter applying in person may pick up a sealed envelope ballot package at the time of application during regular office hours (Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.).

If applying by mail (including email) or fax\*\*, a voter may apply between April 13 and June 20, 2021.

\*\* A voter applying by mail or fax will receive a sealed envelope ballot package by regular post, or by making alternative arrangements with the senior election official.
